ARC/PLC Packets Available at FSA

Primary operators listed for each farm should visit the USDA Farm Service Agency office to obtain their 2018 Program Packet.

The FSA office is located at 402 Kays Drive in Normal. No appointment is needed for pickup.

Included in the packet will be 2018 contract(s) for every farm number(s) associated with that primary operator for the 2018 year.

The primary operator will be responsible for obtaining all necessary signatures for the 2018 ARC/PLC contracts. A signed 2018 cash rent lease may be returned with contracts to cover the owner(s) signature if needed.

Contracts should be reviewed in detail to make sure shares, owners and operators are listed correctly on the farm(s) for the 2018 year. If changes need to be made, do not sign the contract until supporting documentation has been provided to the office and the contracts are updated.

Also included in the packet will be a CCC-941 average adjusted gross income certification (AGI). Each individual/entity that will be receiving a percent of the contract will need to complete one of these forms.

Keep in mind FSA-211 power of attorney does not work on the AGI form.

Failure to enroll a farm during the 2018 enrollment period will prevent a farm from being eligible for assistance for the ARC or PLC programs should crop prices and farm revenues fall below the historical price or revenue benchmarks established by the programs.
