



# Illinois State Board of Elections

## Statewide Advisory Questions for the General Election to be held on November 5, 2024

### INTRODUCTION

Public Act 103-586, effective date May 3, 2024, has listed three statewide advisory questions of public policy to be submitted to the voters at the General Election to be held on November 5, 2024. The Act states that the State Board of Elections shall immediately certify the questions set forth in the Act to be submitted to the voters of the entire State to each election authority in Illinois.

### PUBLIC QUESTIONS SPECIFIED BY STATUTE

All public questions shall be placed on the ballot in a manner pursuant to Section 16-7 of the Election Code after they have been certified by the State Board of Elections. Each question proposed by Public Act 103-586 should appear as follows.

The Election Worker Protection and Candidate Accountability Referendum Act of Public Act 103-586 proposes the following statewide advisory question:

Should any candidate appearing on the Illinois ballot for federal, State, or local office be subject to civil penalties if the candidate interferes or attempts to interfere with an election worker's official duties?	YES

The Property Tax Relief and Fairness Referendum Act of Public Act 103-586 proposes the following statewide advisory question:

Should the Illinois Constitution be amended to create an additional 3% tax on income greater than \$1,000,000 for the purpose of dedicating funds raised to property tax relief?	YES

The Assisted Reproductive Health Referendum Act of Public Act 103-586 proposes the following statewide advisory question:

Should all medically appropriate assisted reproductive treatments, including, but not limited to, in vitro fertilization, be covered by any health insurance plan in Illinois that provides coverage for pregnancy benefits, without limitation on the number of treatments?	YES
